Nominations for this prestigious award may be submitted by family members, friends, co-workers, past and present faculty, or anyone who is aware of the special accomplishments of a Stebbins alumnus. Nominations may also be made by the candidates themselves.

Eligibility

Graduates of Walter E. Stebbins High School may be nominated for the Walter E. Stebbins Outstanding Alumnus Award. Nominees will be judged on their outstanding accomplishments since graduation from our high school.

- Be graduates of at least ten years ago from Stebbins High School (The 2012 award will be considered for members of the 2002 graduation class and before.)
- Exhibit a high level of achievement in both their professional and personal lives.
- Demonstrate integrity and qualities of leadership, character and service in a variety of ways that will motivate others to reach their highest potential.
- Be committed to life-long learning.
- Mad River employees and Board of Education members and their children are not eligible.

Nomination materials will be evaluated by a select committee of teachers, administrators, staff, parents and alumni who value the integrity of the Walter E. Stebbins Outstanding Alumnus Award. There is great emphasis on keeping the selection process fair and unbiased. Award recipients will be notified within one month after the nomination deadline and honored at a ceremony traditionally held in the fall. Their names will be engraved for permanent display on the Wall of Fame outside the high school building.
