Traffic Patterns

Beverly Gardens is a walking school which increases the amount of traffic that we have daily. We realize that the increased traffic may slow down the arrival and dismissal process, but we always have student's safety as our first priority. It is important to remember the following procedures in order for our students to safely enter and exit the building:

- No student shall be dropped off prior to 7:45
- If you are picking up your child, we encourage you to park in the extra lot located beside the front of the school and walk over to the school to pick up your child.
- Please pull up to the curb and let your child out of the car when dropping them off
- If you need to come into the building with your child pull into a parking space so you do not cause a backup of traffic flow
- As soon as your child exits the car, move forward to allow for the other vehicles to drop off and continue through the parking lot
- You may **NOT** leave your car at any time in the drive through lane as this will stop the other traffic
- Do not drop off your child in the middle of the lot between the parking spaces and another car that is along the curb (this is very dangerous for the car pulling away from the curb)
- Cars are not allowed in the back of the school for drop off or pick up at anytime
- When waiting for your child, at the front of the school, please wait on the sidewalk, or at a designated location so that you are not causing overcrowding by the front doors.
- Please drive slowly and carefully through the parking lot .

We appreciate your help and patience during the arrival and dismissal of students.

Reminders

- **School Fees:** School fees are \$30 for the school year. The fees can be paid in quarterly installments or all at once. Students will not receive a report card without a payment for school fees each quarter.
- **School Hours:** The school day begins at 8:00 and ends at 2:10. The office remains open until 3:00. Students should not arrive to school prior to 7:45.
- **Breakfast:** Students have the opportunity to receive a free breakfast every morning between the hours of 7:45 and 8:10.
- **Attendance:** If your child is not in attendance for any reason, it is important that you call the school and bring in a parent or doctor note the following day.
- **Change in transportation:** If you plan on a change in transportation for the afternoon dismissal it is important that you send in a note with your student. We can not accept changes over the phone for the safety and security of your child.
