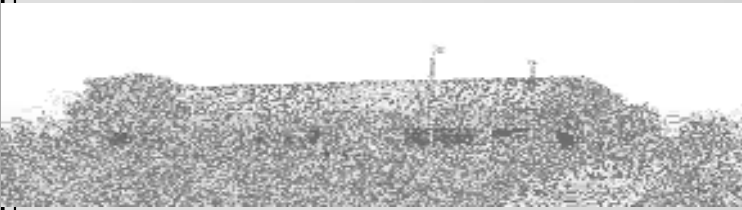

## A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL!



As we begin the second grading period I want to remind parents to please sign up for a conference with your child's teachers. By this time you should have received your child's report card and information regarding conferences which will be held Thursday, November 3rd from 5:00 to 9:00 PM; Friday, November 4th from 8:00 to 3:15 PM; and Thursday, November 10th from 5:00 to 8:15 PM. Please contact your child's teachers if you did not receive information about conferences. Due to conferences, students do not have school on Friday, November 4th.

There will be no school for students on Tuesday, November 8th due to a staff development day. This is also election day. Please remember to exercise your right to vote.

As winter weather approaches please listen to local radio and TV stations to see if Mad River Local Schools are delayed or cancelled. You will also receive a phone call from the One Call system. Students will have outside recess during the winter months as long as the temperature (including wind chill factor) is above 20 degrees. Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothing (hats and gloves included) during the winter season.

I would also like to thank parents for seeing that your child is in school everyday. Our attendance for the first grading period was over 96 percent which is exceeding our goal for the year. ## RECYCLE

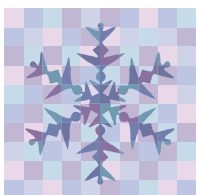

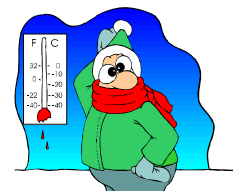
