## Dear Parent/Guardian:

In April Stebbins High School will administer the state mandated End of Course Tests for Algebra 1, ELA II, Geometry, Biology, U.S History, and Government. These tests are part of the graduation requirements per the state of Ohio. Some students will take these tests for the first time and some students will take these tests for a second time to try and earn the state competency score. Students that will be required to retest have been informed through email, and a meeting with their counselor.

Monday, April 17 and Tuesday, April 18 - We will administer the ELA II EOC- part A on Monday and Part B on Tuesday. All sophomores taking English 201 and 202 for the first time, will take this test. All sophomores in a CCP English will take this test. Any upperclassmen or retained students who need to retake this test for graduation eligibility will be notified by guidance that they are required to test.

**Tuesday, April 25**- We will administer the U.S. History and Government EOC. All students taking U.S. History and Government for the first time, will take this test. **Any upperclassmen or retained students who need to retake this test for graduation eligibility will be notified by guidance that they are required to test.** 

Monday, May 1 and Tuesday, May 2- We will administer the Algebra 1 and Geometry EOC Part A on Monday, Part B on Tuesday. All students taking Algebra 1 and Geometry for the first time, will take this test. Any upperclassmen or retained students who need to retake this test for graduation eligibility will be notified by guidance that they are required to test.

**Thursday, May 4** - We will administer the Biology EOC. All students taking Biology for the first time will take this test. *Any upperclassmen or retained students who need to retake this test for graduation eligibility will be notified by guidance that they are required to test.* 

All students will attend school the full day on testing dates. Testing will happen during first period. We will have an extended first period on the testing dates. It is imperative that students arrive to school on time, and get plenty of sleep each night before their test. Also, per the state of Ohio requirements, students are not permitted to have any type of electronic devices (i.e. cell phones, IPods, MP3 players, smart watches, etc.). If your student is caught with a device during testing, it will automatically disqualify them from the test that they are currently taking and they may face administrative consequences.
