

# Kindergarten

## Immunization Schedule

Per the Ohio Department of Health (ODH)

### School Year 2024-2025

**DPT– 5 doses** or 4 doses if 4<sup>th</sup> dose was given on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

**Polio – 3 or more doses** – the FINAL dose MUST be on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

**MMR – 2 doses** - 1<sup>st</sup> dose MUST be on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

**Hepatitis B – 3 doses**

**Varicella – 2 doses** - 1<sup>st</sup> dose MUST be on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

**If immunizations are not up-to-date, or in process\* by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of school, you must keep your child home until immunizations are current. (Per the ODH)**

\*In Process “means that the students have all the vaccines they can get at this time, but are not complete. They must wait the minimum interval before they get additional doses.”

**Please provide a photocopy of the official shot record to the school**

### For parents of all incoming kindergarteners

Though your child’s immunization record was very likely up-to-date for their preschool years, most children coming into kindergarten now need another set of immunizations. Please contact your doctor soon to schedule an appointment to be sure your child’s records are complete by the first day of the new school year. The additional immunizations needed to enter Kindergarten and that are frequently missing from our records are the following:

- 5<sup>th</sup> DPT
- 4<sup>th</sup> Polio
- 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella
