

# Mad River Local Schools Cleaning, PPE Guidance and Updates on the 2021-22 School Year Beginning June 2, 2021, and Beyond until Further Notice.

# **All District Facilities:**

Our maintenance and custodial staff have elevated the level of cleaning and disinfection throughout our district facilities over the past 14 months per best practices and guidance from Public Health and the CDC. These cleaning regiments meet and exceed the expectations of surface cleaning and sanitation, additional cleaning by staff will no longer be expected.

Water bottle filling stations will remain the sole source of drinking water for students and staff. Drinking fountains will remain inoperable throughout summer school and possibly into the foreseeable future.

#### **Adult-Student interactions & Student-Student Interactions**

Locations include classrooms, cafeterias, gymnasiums, auditoriums, hallways, outdoor spaces (i.e. playgrounds, parking lots, green spaces), and buses.

PK-6 Guidance: Facial coverings (masks, face shields, gators) will be welcomed but not required.

Effective at midnight on June 1, 2021, adults interacting on school premises with other adults are welcome to wear masks but not required.

# **2021-2022 School Year**

Effective September 7, 2021, students will return to full in-person learning, five days per week, for the 2021-22 school year.

- Ninth-grade orientation will take place on August 27, 2021.
- Seventh-grade orientation will take place on September 2, 2021.

More information about the beginning of the year will be provided to families in August.
